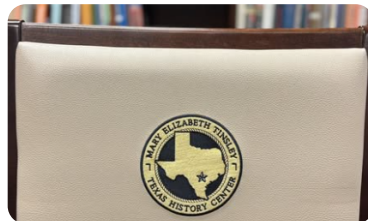


Gonzales Old Jail Museum

The Gonzales County Jail Museum, also known as the Old Jail Museum, is a historic 1885 building in Gonzales, TX, that offers a glimpse into Texas law enforcement history, featuring original cells, rebuilt gallows, and former sheriff's and jailer's quarters.

Belle Oaks Inn

The "Belle Oaks Inn" is likely what you are looking for; it is a historic Greek Revival mansion and bed & breakfast in Gonzales, Texas, built in 1912



Mary Elizabeth Tinsley Texas History Center

This collection is housed within the library and features historical artifacts and documents, particularly from the Texas Revolution era.

Charles DuBose Gun & Militaria Collection

Housed in the (library) building's old bank vault, this collection features historical pistols, rifles, military memorabilia, and helmets.

Lynn Theater – 7pm (Dessert & Dialogue)

The Lynn Theater was built in 1947 by Lynn Smith Sr. and was in operation until the 1970s. The theater, with its classic Art Deco charm, now screens movies and hosts special events, serving as a cultural landmark in downtown Gonzales, TX.



Gonzales Memorial Museum – 8:30pm

There is nothing like this in the world! Showcased on the museum itself – view the **Texas Legacy in Lights!**

The Gonzales Memorial Museum was built in 1936–37 features the original "Come and Take It" cannon that sparked the Texas Revolution.
